Olympic team goes hunting for the hunters

In 2013 a team of Brazilian sports people went to the Amazon rainforest. $^{1}_$ search for young people with amazing sporting skills to take part in the 2016 Olympics in Rio and to represent Brazil.

They found twelve young people who were impressive kayakers, and others who had fantastic skills with a bow and arrow. One of these was a quiet teenager called Jardel Kambeba, from the Kambeba tribe.
